Day 1: Journey Begins to Rapid City, SD

As you travel westward, you'll stop at **Wall Drug**, one of the world's most well-known tourist attractions, before arriving in Rapid City, SD, for the evening.

Day 2: Rapid City, SD to Rock Springs, WY

This morning, visit **The Mammoth Site** to explore this internationally renowned indoor working paleontological site at your leisure, where over 60 mammoths have been unearthed!

Day 3: Rock Springs, WY to Salt Lake City, UT

Today begins with a guided tour of **Park City Museum**. Prospectors discovered silver in Park City, Utah in 1868, which was the beginning of this historic town, now one of Utah's excellent ski resort towns. Explore this beautiful city on your own with some free time before continuing your guided tour of **Utah's Olympic Park**, the site of the 2002 Olympic Winter Games located in Park City. Your day concludes with a visit to the **Land Cruiser Heritage Museum**, where you explore the history of the Toyota Land Cruiser.

Day 4: Salt Lake City, UT

This morning, you'll tour the **Red Butte Garden** at your leisure. It is the most extensive botanical garden in the Intermountain West, with 21 acres of developed gardens and over a half-million blooms! You'll then enjoy free time to explore the "must-experience" Salt Lake City **Farmer's Market** and **Art & Craft Market**. Later, you'll visit the **Natural History Museum of Utah**, the state's official natural history museum. Home to over 163,000 sq feet of exhibits exploring billions of years of natural history. The afternoon concludes with free time to explore Ogden's **Union Station and Historic 25th Street**. Union Station contains four separate museums to explore. Historic 25th Street began in the rough-and-tumble frontier days and grew into the unique street it is today.

Day 5: Salt Lake City, UT

Enjoy a guided **Salt Lake City Bus Tour** complete with a performance by the world-famous **Tabernacle Choir**. Following the tour, visit downtown Salt Lake City, home to more than a million square feet of shopping, dining, and more. This afternoon, the **Snowbird's Aerial Tram** will whisk you along a 1.6-mile cable and up 2,900 vertical feet to the top of Hidden Peak. The view at the time will be breathtaking.

Day 6: Salt Lake City, UT

Start your day at the **Bonneville Salt Flats**, one of Utah's most unique natural features. Covering over 30,000 acres, it is perfectly flat and has a thick crust of salty soil, making it appear like a frozen lake bed. Later, enjoy a guided tour of **Wendover Historic Airfield & Museum**. The Wendover Airfield is the most original remaining and authentically preserved WWII Army Air Force base in the US. A step-on-guide will join you this afternoon for a **Great Salt Lake Tour** and share the myths and mysteries of Great Salt Lake. The guided tour is full of entertaining stories and fascinating facts, and you'll discover the saltiest lake in the Western Hemisphere: America's Dead Sea!

Day 7: Salt Lake City, UT to Cheyenne, WY

Arriving in Wyoming this afternoon, you'll have a guided tour of the **Wyoming Frontier Prison**. The eighty-year history of Wyoming's first state Penitentiary is a remnant of the grizzly past of the Old West.

Day 8: Cheyenne, WY to Lincoln, NE

This afternoon, visit the **Great Platte River Road Archway Museum**, which tells the story of the adventurers who followed the Great Platte River Road across Nebraska and helped to build America. The museum is filled with numerous interactive displays for you to enjoy.

Day 9: Lincoln, NE to Home

Before arriving home, you will visit the **Sioux City Lewis & Clark Interpretive Center**, which showcases permanent exhibits depicting 1804, when the expedition was in the present-day Sioux City area. The museum is filled with various interactive devices to help tell the expedition's story. You will arrive home early evening.
