SOUTHERN TEXAS

With Extended Stay in McAllen

January 18 - 31, 2023



Day 1: Home to Topeka, KS

Today is a travel day as you begin your journey to southern Texas.

Day 2: Topeka, KS to Ardmore, OK

Arriving in Oklahoma City today, you'll have a guided tour of the **National Cowboy and Western Heritage Museum**, which features a collection of classic and contemporary Western art. In addition, there is a turn-of-the-century town, interactive history galleries that focus on the American cowboy, rodeos, Native American culture, Victorian firearms, frontier military, and more.

Day 3: Ardmore, OK to Austin, TX

Today you'll arrive in Texas! Enjoy lunch and free time in Waco at the **Magnolia Market** at the Silos, the site owned and made famous by designers and television personalities Chip and Joanna Gaines. Following lunch, visit **Harp Designs**, a furniture design store owned by Clint Harp, a regular on the Chip and Joanna Gaines television shows and now the star of his new television show "Restoration Road."

Day 4: Austin, TX to San Antonio, TX

Enjoy the world-famous San Antonio River Walk with a **Go Rio Cruise**, where you can capture the river city's sights, wonders, and culture. Following your cruise, visit **The Alamo**, right in the heart of San Antonio. This is one of Texas' most visited historical landmarks, and home to the famous 1836 battle and provides living history demonstrations so you can experience the battlefield firsthand. This afternoon you'll see the 750-foot **Tower of the Americas** with a stop at the Flags Over Texas Observation Deck for a mesmerizing view of the city below.

Day 5: San Antonio, TX

Today is a **free day** to enjoy as you wish. Perhaps you would like to explore further the River Walk and the many shops and restaurants it offers. Or maybe you would like to visit the historic Market Square, the Spanish Governor's Palace, or San Fernando Cathedral, or join a Hop-On Hop-Off San Antonio Tour. San Antonio has so much to offer; your options are almost endless!

Day 6: San Antonio, TX to McAllen, TX

Arriving in Corpus Christi this morning, there is a guided tour of the **USS Lexington** or "The Blue Ghost," a WWII aircraft carrier, now a naval museum featuring airplanes, an IMAX Theater with historical films, and more. Following lunch, explore the **Texas State Aquarium**, which focuses solely on the sea life found in the Gulf of Mexico and the Caribbean Sea. You'll find the nursery portion of the aquarium incredibly enticing and their rescue and rehabilitation areas as well.

Day 7 and Day 8: McAllen, TX

These two days are **free days** in McAllen. Perhaps you would like to lounge at the pool and soak up the sun. Maybe you would like to go to the Mercado District and do some shopping. There are numerous restaurants to try out the different cuisines of southern Texas. Or perhaps you have friends that winter in McAllen and you would like to visit with them or maybe you are considering wintering here and would like to check out this winter community for yourself!

Day 9: McAllen, TX to Victoria, TX

Heading to the beautiful beach area of the South Padre Islands, the day will begin at the **South Padre Island Birding and Nature Center**. This guided tour takes you on a beachfront boardwalk with interactive exhibits and observation towers, allowing you to see numerous birds, turtles, and maybe even some alligators! Then board your 60' tour boat for **The Original Dolphin Watch** cruise. Experience the thrill of meeting bottlenose and spinner dolphins in the wild and experience the unique bond and kinship they inspire in mankind.

Day 10: Victoria, TX to Woodlands, TX

Most of today will be spent exploring the **Space Center Houston** at your own pace based on your interests. You can do the NASA Tram Tour, the Johnson Space Center, Astronaut Training Facility, Apollo Mission Control, and much more. Later in the day, tour the **Lone Star Flight Museum**. This aerospace museum displays more than 24 historically significant aircraft related to the history of flight.

Day 11: Woodlands, TX to Frisco, TX

Fort Worth Stock Yards will be featured today. From the cattle drive, which is done twice daily, to the many shops, restaurants, museums, saloons, historical landmarks, and more, you'll find a great deal to do in Fort Worth. The entire town is dedicated to keeping the spirit of Texas' livestock history alive!

Day 12: Frisco, TX

In Dallas today, your **DFW Tour** includes a tour of key downtown Dallas locations and then will explore the history of the JFK assassination. Tour includes visiting Lee Harvey Oswald's rooming house and the Texas Theatre where they arrested Oswald, a tour of Dealey Plaza, driving the motorcade route, and much more. Following is a self-guided tour of the **Sixth Floor Museum** at Dealey Plaza featuring comprehensive exhibits on John F. Kennedy's presidency and assassination at the site of the sniper's nest.

Day 13: Frisco, TX to Emporia, KS

As you begin your journey home, you'll arrive in Oklahoma City this morning for a self-guided tour of the **Oklahoma City National Memorial and Museum**. You can journey through touchscreens, galleries, and theaters where the powerful story unfolds of that fateful day in our history.

Day 14: Emporia, KS to Home

Your Southern Texas tour concludes today as you arrive home this evening.

ARIZONA WINTER GETAWAY

February 21 - March 6, 2023



Day 1: Home to Kearney, NE

Today is a travel day as you begin your journey to Arizona.

Day 2: Kearney, NE to Colorado Springs, CO

Traveling to Colorado Springs today, enjoy a guided tour of the **Garden of the Gods**. As a registered National Natural Landmark, you will see 300 feet towering sandstone rock formations against a backdrop of snow-capped Pikes Peak. Tour the Visitor and Nature Center and be sure to see the view from the terrace, one of the most photographed views in Colorado.

Day 3: Colorado Springs, CO to Albuquerque, NM

Arriving in Albuquerque this afternoon, ride the **Sandia Peak Aerial Tramway**, which stretches from the northeast edge of Albuquerque to the Crestline of the Sandia Mountains and has the world's third-longest single span!

Day 4: Albuquerque, NM to Holbrook, AZ

Your morning begins with a drive through the **Petrified Forest National Park**, one of the world's largest and most vibrantly colored assemblies of petrified wood, historic structures, and archaeological sites. At the **Painted Desert Visitor Center**, you'll experience hands-on exhibits to get in touch with the natural landscape. Your last activity of the day is the **Rainbow Forest Trail and Museum**.

Day 5: Holbrook, AZ to Williams, AZ

Your first full day in Arizona starts with a visit to the **Sunset Crater National Monument and Visitor Center**. Learn about the volcanic eruption 900 years ago that forever changed the landscape. Walk down the Lava Flow Crater Loop to the base of Sunset Crater Volcano. At the Cameron Trading Post, enjoy lunch and some free time for shopping. Afterward, visit the magnificent **Grand Canyon**, with stops at various locations such as Desert View Watchtower for pictures and viewing. You'll also stop at the Canyon View Information Plaza, where there is time to enjoy the Visitor Center or walk the Rim Trail.

Day 6: Williams, AZ to Tempe, AZ

Today begins with everyone's favorite, the **Pink Jeep Tours!** Experience a true four-wheel-drive adventure on and over Sedona red rocks as your guide shares Native American History and information on geology, flora, and fauna. At **Montezuma Castle National Monument**, gaze through the windows of the past into one of the best-preserved cliff dwellings in North America. See first hand the ingenuity it took to survive in this unforgiving desert. At the **Montezuma Well**, the legacy of the Sinagua culture surrounds you. The variety of the archeological sites here is a testament to the ingenuity of these people.

Day 7: Tempe, AZ

Enjoy a **Guided Tour of the Phoenix area**, including sites such as the Arizona Capitol Museum, Camelback Mountain, a drive through Paradise Valley, lunch, and shopping in Old Scottsdale, and more.

Day 8: Tempe, AZ

The day is yours to enjoy as you wish.

Day 9: Tempe, AZ

The morning is yours to fill with your personal interests or simply relax at the hotel. This afternoon you'll visit the **Desert Botanical Garden**, home to one of the world's most spectacular living collections of desert plants. This evening includes **Barleen's Arizona Opry Dinner Theatre**. Be entertained by the musicians versatility, hilarious comedians, and top-notch variety entertainers that team up to delight you while enjoying a delicious meal just like Grandma used to make!

Day 10: Tempe, AZ

Begin your day at Agritopia Barnone, an unique craftsman community, and Joe's Farm Grill for free time to shop and enjoy lunch on your own. Joe's Farm Grill was featured on Food Networks Diner, Drive-Ins & Dives. You'll be sure to find something delicious to eat. After lunch, enjoy a scenic nature cruise on Canyon Lake aboard the **Dolly Steamboat**. The one-and-a-half-hour cruise offers opportunities to see local wildlife from the decks of the Dolly and prove there is more to Arizona than deserts! Following the cruise, there is free time in Tortilla Flat before returning to the hotel.

Day 11: Tempe, AZ to Gallup, NM

In Mesa this morning, there is a guided tour of the **Arizona Museum of Natural History**, dedicated to inspire wonder, respect, and understand the natural and cultural history of the Southwest.

WASHINGTON D.C. and HISTORY OF COLONIAL WILLIAMSBURG, VA

March 26 - April 7, 2023



Day 1: Home to Galesburg, IL

Today is a travel day as you begin your journey to our U.S. Capital city.

Day 2: Galesburg, IL to Springfield, OH

Arriving in Indiana this afternoon, you'll enjoy a guided tour of **Benjamin Harrison Presidential Site**, including the beautiful Victorian home he and his wife Caroline shared. Harrison served as our 23rd president, and the site is filled with personal and presidential items.

Day 3: Springfield, OH to Gettysburg, PA

Your Tour Director will take you on a late afternoon walk-through of the **Gettysburg National Cemetery**; the final resting place for more than 3,500 Union soldiers who were killed in the Battle of Gettysburg. Gettysburg is also the site of the infamous Gettysburg Address made by President Lincoln.

Day 4: Gettysburg, PA to Vienna, VA

This morning features a guided Battlefield Tour of the **Gettysburg National Military Park**. While it lasted only three days, it was one of the most crucial battles of the Civil War. Your guide will take you to key locations within the park and give you insight into what took place. You will then stop at the **Gettysburg National Parks Visitor Center**, where you can explore on your own the museum, the Cyclorama, and more. This afternoon you'll cross the Potomac River for a guided tour of **George Washington's Mount Vernon**. The home, originally started as a farmhouse by Washington's father. When George and Martha acquired the home they slowly enlarged the residence over the next 45 years to the 21-room residence of today.

Day 5: Vienna, VA

Feel the pulse of the most critical city in the United States with your guided tour of **Washington D.C.** Some of the featured highlights include a **U.S. Capitol Tour**, the **Library of Congress**, and the **Supreme Court**. This afternoon, you'll continue with a tour of the **United States Holocaust Memorial Museum**, a living memorial of the Holocaust, providing a powerful lesson on the fragility of freedom. This evening, you'll immerse yourself in the Nation's Capitol sights and beauty at twilight with a **DC Trails Light City Tour**.

Day 6: Vienna, VA

Your guided tour of the city continues today, beginning with **Arlington National Cemetery**. Following lunch, you'll continue to see some of the more popular sites in Washington, such as the Iwo Jima Memorial, Vietnam and Korean memorials, WWII Memorial, National 9/11 Pentagon Memorial, and more. See the Changing of the Guard and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.

Day 7: Vienna, VA

The day begins at the **Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception**. The Basilica is the largest Roman Catholic church in the US and North America, and the beauty alone is breathtaking! You are welcome to attend mass or enjoy free time in the cafeteria in the lower level for non-church-goers. Your morning will conclude with a visit to the Washington Monument. Later enjoy a guided tour of the **Museum of the Bible** where interactive exhibits and cutting-edge technology will give you, an immersive, personal experience and history of the Bible. The remainder of the day is yours to explore other Smithsonian museums or attractions in the area.

Day 8: Vienna, VA to Williamsburg, VA

You'll begin your journey to Williamsburg today, driving The Colonial Parkway, which links Jamestown Settlement, Historic Jamestown, Colonial Williamsburg, Yorktown Battlefield, and the American Revolution Museum at Yorktown! Your first stop will be the **Jamestown Settlement** for a guided tour. Hear the Jamestown story and interactions with the Powhatan Indian, visits to the re-created Pasphegh town, colonial fort, and 1607 ships, as well as the Jamestown Settlement galleries. Following lunch, in Yorktown, there will be a guided tour of the **American Revolution Museum at Yorktown**. Here you'll explore life during the American Revolution and learn about the impact on the diverse people of America and the development of the new nation.

Day 9: Williamsburg, VA to Allen, VA

Today in **Colonial Williamsburg**, the world's largest living history museum, get ready to experience the living, breathing 18th-century colonial capital! Your morning will include a guided tour of Colonial Williamsburg, leaving the afternoon to explore on your own. You will have various options to fill your afternoon, from horse carriage rides to art museums, blacksmith shops, stage shows, etc.

Day 10: Allen, VA to Morehead, KY

As you begin making your journey home, you'll stop in West Virginia at the New River Gorge Visitor Center. Enjoy the breathtaking views of the New River Gorge Bridge and gorge.

Day 11: Morehead, KY to Harrison, OH

While in Kentucky, you'll visit two of the most popular attractions, the **Ark Encounter** and the **Creation Museum**. These two sites see nearly 1.5 million people per year and remain one of our most requested sites for tours!

Day 12: Harrison, OH to Coralville, IA

This afternoon, in Dixon, IL, you have a guided tour of **Ronald Reagan's Boyhood Home**. This is the home of his earliest and most fond memories. It is filled with artifacts, memorabilia, and period furniture to restore the home to its 1920 appearance.

Day 1: Home to Overland Park, KS

Sit back and enjoy the scenery aboard your luxury motor coach as you travel south to Kansas today.

Day 2: Overland Park, KS to Bartlesville, OK

Today you'll travel to Ponca City, Oklahoma. See the Statue of the Pioneer Woman. Standing stately, she is a statement to the courage it took the women pioneers of yesteryear. Later, visit the **E.W Marland Mansion & Estate**. Learn the story of the Marland family, the oil industry that made building this architectural wonder possible, and Ponca City, the "oil boom-town" that rose from it.

Day 3: Bartlesville, OK

This morning, in downtown **Pawhuska**, celebrate past, present, and future with free time to explore on your own. Pawhuska, founded in 1876, still has 86 buildings in the downtown area listed on the National Register of Historic Places! There is an included lunch at the **Pioneer Woman Mercantile**, allowing you an opportunity to try this "Southern" style of home cooking. While at The Mercantile, aka "The Merc," you can shop all things Pioneer Woman. SMOKING/LIQUOR: No smoking, chewing tobacco, or open liquor is allowed on the motor coach with some exceptions. Frequent stops are made to accommodate those wishing to smoke. Southwest Tour and Travel reserves the right to not transport a person or persons if intoxicated, under the influence of drugs, or if their conduct is offensive to other travelers. It will be the responsibility of the passenger denied boarding to arrange and pay for their return home.

PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION: All travelers need a government issued photo ID for all travel and Real ID compliant for domestic air travel in 2023. In addition, Southwest Tour and Travel requires a valid passport for anyone traveling outside the U.S. on one of our tours and for any government sites that require a passport. Passports must be valid at least six-months past your return date. If a visa, or special immunizations are required, it will be stated on the itinerary.

SEATING ARRANGEMENTS: For the enjoyment of all passengers, there is a daily seat rotation in which all passengers, by booking a tour, agree to accept and participate. This allows everyone to experience the tour from different areas of the motor coach and offers a better opportunity to get to know fellow passengers. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Passengers suffering from motion sickness are advised to take the necessary precautions.

CLOTHING: We recommend for all of our tours that you wear comfortable shoes made for walking. Bring clothing that can be layered easily for changing weather conditions. Bringing a raincoat that can easily be folded and stored is always a good idea. If special events or activities require more dressy attire, our staff will point this out to you before departure. However, our detailed itineraries are a good guide in letting you know what activities/events you will do each day. We suggest you bring a bathing suit if you enjoy utilizing the hotel pools and jacuzzis.

PARKING: Free parking is available at Southwest Tour and Travel and at most of our designated pickup locations. Arrangements for parking at our designated pickup locations must be made through our office. If you are boarding the motor coach at another location other than Southwest Tour and Travel, or our designated pickup location, you must make arrangements to park there and obtain permission from that property.

WEATHER & OTHER DELAYS: Additional expenses incurred due to circumstances beyond our control, for motor coach or leisure travel, will not be the responsibility of Southwest Tour and Travel.

BED BUGS: Southwest Tour and Travel makes every effort to choose quality accommodations. However, due to the increase of bed bugs in resorts/hotels, if there is an occurrence, we will not accept liability for losses due to exposure. It is recommended that you follow the bed bug guidelines in your packet.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When should I make a reservation?

We suggest making your reservation as soon as possible to ensure availability and to capture potential discounts. If we don't know you are interested, a tour can be canceled for lack of registrations when there were actually many people waiting to sign up all along!

What is the pace of a tour?

For your convenience, we have assigned Activity Levels to each tour. You'll find it noted on each tour brochure. Please reference the Activity Level Guide in our brochure for additional details and an explanation of each level. Please get in touch with our office if you are unsure if the pace will suit you.

Is there a restroom on the motor coach?

Yes, although we plan our tours so that the typical time between restroom stops is generally not longer than two and a half hours.

How much time will I spend on the motor coach?

Each tour day varies depending on the itinerary and the miles involved. Some days you may not be on the motor coach much at all, while the days getting to your destination or getting home may be more significant in duration.

Will I need to carry my own luggage?

We strive to ensure luggage service is available at the hotels we select. However, guests occasionally will have to wheel luggage in and out of a hotel. Guests are allowed a small overnight case, backpack, or tote bag on the motor coach that can be stored in the overhead bin. This will always be your responsibility to carry into the hotel each night.

Are tips included?

Tips are included in the tour package for pre-planned activities and events. Tips for the Tour Director and Motor Coach Driver are not included in the tour price. You are encouraged to express your appreciation for their work and dedication in providing a great travel experience.

What kind of hotels do you generally book?

A quality hotel is vital for the comfort of our guests, with a focus on cleanliness and location. We strive to select the best options available while keeping an eye on price to ensure we give our travelers the best experience for the best price.

Why do single travelers pay more?

If you are traveling by yourself, the costs of hotel accommodations are incurred by one person instead of two. Therefore, single accommodations cost more than double or triple packages.

Can you assist in finding me a roommate?

If you are a single traveler and are interested in finding a roommate for the trip to share travel costs, please let us know this when registering. In that case, we can certainly introduce you to travelers with the same interest.

How many beds are in each room?

Rooms will have either two queens or two double beds.

Can I get a handicapped-accessible room?

Hotels have a minimal number of handicapped-accessible rooms. If you require a handicapped-accessible room, you must request it immediately upon signing up for a tour. We will make every effort to accommodate your request.

If it says “Breakfast Included,” what will be served?

Generally, a typical breakfast includes a selection of hot and cold cereals, a selection of bread, fruits, yogurts, coffee, tea, milk, and juice. Most include eggs, meats, and some pastries. Occasionally the hotel will serve a bagged breakfast or a cooked-to-order breakfast.

When will I receive my final tour documents?

You will receive your tour documents about three (3) weeks before your tour. You should read through all your documents immediately upon receiving them to ensure you understand everything about your upcoming tour.

What will I need for ID for my motor coach trip?

Each brochure will expressly state if you need any special identification, such as a passport. If nothing is said, then your driver’s license or government issued ID will be sufficient.

Why am I asked to sign a release for photographs?

Our Tour Director will often take group pictures at significant destinations and photos of fun activities or events you participate in throughout the tour. For the Tour Director to share these with your fellow travelers, you must sign a Release so we can share these pictures of you. In addition, when a tour is out, we like to keep our Facebook followers updated on what our travelers are doing, so we share those pictures on Facebook. We do not identify each traveler in the image, but we do point out where the group is and what they are doing.

May I bring a wheelchair, walker, or other walking assistance device?

Foldable wheelchairs and walkers are welcome. They are not permitted onboard the motorcoach and will be stored in the baggage compartment. If you intend to bring a wheelchair or walker, please notify us when you register. We can accommodate **motorized** wheelchairs of a specific size and weight. Please contact us with weight and size dimensions to ensure our coach can accommodate your wheelchair. Southwest Tour and Travel / Southwest Coaches personnel cannot lift or physically assist guests.

What are your Covid Policies?

At this time, Southeast Tour and Travel and Southwest Coaches is not requiring either a negative test or vaccination proof. However, for everyone's peace of mind, if you are not feeling well before departure, ensuring you do not have Covid would be greatly appreciated.

What if I get sick while on tour?

If you believe you may have Covid, we encourage you to test immediately as a courtesy to your fellow passengers. Our Tour Director usually carries home testing kits and can provide you a test kit. If the test kit comes back positive, you will need to quarantine immediately and will need to leave the tour. If you are unable to continue your tour due to Covid or any other type of illness, you will be responsible for all costs related to the illness and those incurred to return home. You will be subject to the cancellation penalties as published for your tour. If you have travel insurance, our team will assist you in filing a claim for the these additional costs and the losses you incurred.


