GRAND HOTEL GETAWAY ON MACKINAC ISLAND

Day 1: Journey Begins to Schofield, WI

Today, your journey begins to beautiful Mackinac Island. Arriving in Wausau, WI, you'll have a guided tour of the [Yawkey House Museum](#). At the time of its construction, the Yawkey House was the most expensive home of one of Wausau's most prominent families and the leader of the Wausau Group.

Day 2: Schofield, WI to Munising, MI

Today begins at the [Wabeno Logging Museum](#), which contains memorabilia and records in a replica of an old logging camp. Later, at the [Lakeland Sculpture Park](#), enjoy a leisurely stroll through the winding paths of this 37-acre park, which contains hundreds of Tom Lakenen's whimsical metal art sculptures.

Day 3: Munising, WI to Mackinac Island, MI

Today, you'll spot the iconic [Mackinac Bridge](#) in St. Ignace, MI. There will be time for viewing and picture taking. From here, you'll visit the [Old Mackinac Point Lighthouse](#), built in 1889, and now, with fully restored quarters, it provides a look back in time. It also offers fantastic panoramic lake views! Then [Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry](#) will carry you across the water to [Mackinac Island](#), where your [Horse Carriage](#) awaits to whisk you away to the [Grand Hotel](#). You'll have two nights at the Grand Hotel, which has been rich in history and tradition since 1887, offering exceptional accommodations, with each guest room uniquely decorated. This outstanding hotel has hosted Hollywood's elite, politicians, recording artists, etc.

Day 4: Mackinac Island, MI

After a delicious breakfast at the Grand Hotel, you'll take a [Guided Tour of Mackinac Island by Horse Drawn Carriage](#). A Carriage Tour is the most authentic and enjoyable way to enjoy an island that doesn't allow any motorized vehicles! After a "[Grand Lunch](#)" at the hotel, your afternoon will be free to explore at your leisure. You may enjoy the many amenities of the Grand Hotel or perhaps take in the incredible natural beauty and timeless character of shopping in downtown Mackinac Island. Of course, you'll want to check out the well-known fudge, but there is jewelry, artwork, home decor, antiques, and much more. This evening features an included dinner in the Main Dining Room of the Grand Hotel, where the evening dress code will apply. This landmark dining destination offers a picturesque setting, old-world hospitality, and exceptional food and overlooks the hotel's 660-foot porch, which is said to be the world's longest!

Day 5: Mackinac Island, MI - Grand Rapids, MI

Departing the Grand Hotel this morning, you'll board *Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry* to sail back to the mainland. Later, in Grand Rapids, MI, there is a *Guided Tram Tour at Frederik Meijer Gardens & Sculpture Park*. Known as one of the nation's most significant sculpture and botanic experiences, this is an experience you'll honestly remember.

Day 6: Grand Rapids, MI - Manitowoc, WI

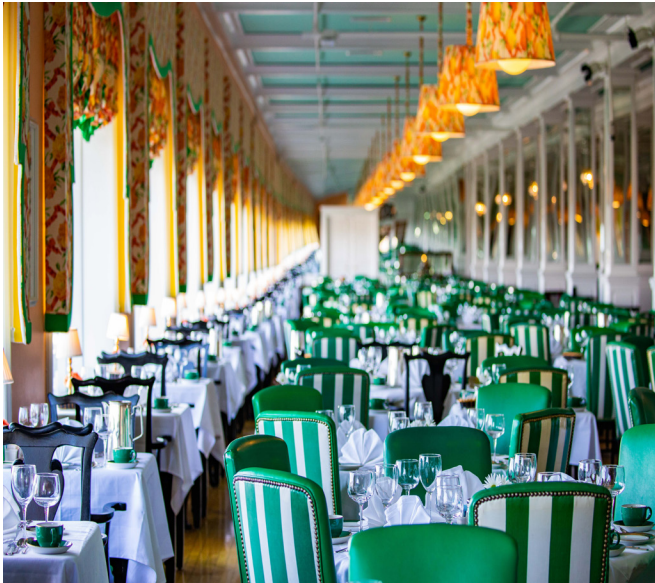
You'll board the *S.S. Badger Lake Michigan Carferry* this morning to cross from Michigan to Wisconsin. In Manitowoc, WI, you'll tour the *Farm Wisconsin Discovery Center*. Here, you can explore over 10,000 sq. feet of interactive exhibits featuring Wisconsin's robust and diverse agriculture industry, which contributes almost \$105 billion to the state's economy! Your next stop is the *Rahr-West Art Museum*, located in a 19th-century historic Victorian mansion filled with American and International art. You'll find notables such as Picasso, Georgia O'Keeffe, Andy Warhol, and more.

Day 7: Manitowoc, WI to Tomah, WI

Arriving in Two Rivers, WI, this morning, enjoy a guided tour at *London Dairy Alpaca Ranch*. This was one of the first Alpaca ranches in Wisconsin, and the tour provides an educational look at breeding, fiber production, and more. The ranch also has items for sale made from alpaca fiber, as well as wine. You'll also visit the *Wisconsin Maritime Museum*, the Midwest's largest maritime museum. The museum provides an opportunity to learn about sailors, shipbuilders, and submariners who made history.

Day 8: Tomah, WI to Home

As you make your way home today, there will be a stop in Austin, MN for a tour of the ever-popular *SPAM Museum*. You'll learn the history, origin, and SPAM's place in world culture.
