Day 1: Journey Begins to Moline, IL

Sit back, relax aboard our luxury motor coach, and enjoy the beautiful autumn scenery as you begin your journey to New England. This afternoon, you'll enjoy a self-guided tour at the [*Herbert Hoover Presidential Library & Museum*](#). Here, you'll find authentic items dedicated to President Hoover's life and presidency.

Day 2: Moline, IL to Maumee, OH

Your tour director will keep you entertained and highlight all the interesting sites as you travel toward the East Coast. Enjoy a stop at the [*RV Hall of Fame & Museum*](#), an entertaining shrine to RVing. You'll find early 1913 to today's state-of-the-art travel trailers, including custom-built, one-of-a-kind items for Hollywood legends.

Day 3: Maumee, OH to Erie, PA

Arriving in Ohio this morning, you'll tour the [*Rock & Roll Hall of Fame*](#). This iconic museum is filled with pop-culture memorabilia, artifacts, instruments, and more from the legends of music we all know and love. Later, a guided tour of the famous house from "[*A Christmas Story*](#)." Here you can immerse yourself in the world of Ralphie Park and his family. You'll also tour the museum. Enjoy a Sunset Dinner Cruise on the Victorian Princess this evening as you sail Erie Bay.

Day 4: Erie, PA to Utica, NY

You'll arrive at Niagara Falls this morning and enjoy the ever-popular [*Maid of the Mist Tour*](#). You'll step aboard the iconic Maid of the Mist, the original Niagara Falls boat tour, offering you the experience of a lifetime!

Day 5: Utica, NY to Fairlee, VT

Set sail on Lake George today for a [*Luncheon Cruise*](#). You'll board the Lac Du Saint Sacrament to enjoy the splendorous autumn colors while enjoying the relaxing luncheon cruise around the lake.

Day 6: Fairlee, VT to Lincoln, NH

An exciting day is in store for you! You'll first enjoy lunch at the base station of the Cog Railroad and visit the museum. Then, you board the *Mount Washington Cog Railroad* for a rare glimpse of a world gone by while enjoying spectacular views as you travel up some of the steepest railroad tracks.

Day 7: Lincoln, NH to Northeast Harbor, ME

Today, you will tour the *Fort Knox and Penobscot Narrows Observatory*. The Fort Knox Historic Site, constructed in the mid-1800s, is one of the best-preserved examples of coastal defense fortifications. It is the tallest bridge observatory open to the public in the world! When visiting the observatory, you will take the fastest elevator in Maine, up 420', for breathing taking 360-degree views of the Penobscot Bay Area.

Day 8: Northeast Harbor, ME

The day is all about *Acadia National Park*. Your local step-on guide will join you for a tour through one of America's most beautiful and treasured National Parks. You'll visit Thunder Hole and other scenic picture stops. Travel to the top of Cadillac Mountain for spectacular views of Frenchman's Bay, Porcupine Island, and Bar Harbor. In the afternoon, embark on a scenic nature cruise of Frenchman Bay. Enjoy the views of Acadia, all the islands, lighthouses, and the Downeast Coast from the water while looking for wildlife such as porpoises, seals, and seabirds. You'll have free time in Bar Harbor Village to explore and dine independently.

Day 9: Northeast Harbor, ME – Ogunquit, ME

Your guide today will help you discover Maine's charming southern coast. You'll visit famous *York Beach* and the *Nubble Light* at Maine's most photographed lighthouse and hear about the long history of the lighthouse keepers. Visit the quaint seaside town of Ogunquit and the fishing village community of Perkins Cove. Enjoy views of the Bush Estate and tour the Franciscan Monastery in Kennebunkport. Later, you will get a first-hand experience at lobstering when you enjoy your *Lobster Boat Cruise* aboard the Finestkind I. You will see traps hauled and lobsters caught, hear detailed explanations of the lobster fishery, and see many scenic points of interest along the way.

Day 10: Ogunquit, ME – Hyannis, MA

Today begins with a *Historic Guided Tour of Boston*. Your step-on guide will help you follow the Freedom Trail into Colonial Revolutionary Boston. You'll see the historic sites that make Boston famous, including the USS Constitution, Boston Commons, Old Granary Burial Ground, Old State House, Bunker Hill, and the site of the Boston Tea Party. Later, watch a re-enactment of the *Boston Tea Party* aboard the ships. You'll meet the colonists, explore the ships, and dump tea overboard just as the Sons of Liberty did many years ago! The day concludes with a stop at *Abigail's Tea Room* for teatime and time for gift shopping.

Day 11: Hyannis, MA

Set out for a day of touring around Cape Cod with your guide. You'll continue to the Cape Cod National Seashore for magnificent views of the Atlantic Ocean. When arriving in Provincetown, at the tip of the Cape, enjoy a one-house *Provincetown Dune Tour*. This relaxing tour takes you through the sand dunes in the comfort of your climate-controlled Suburban. Select a restaurant of your choice on the *Hyannis Main Street Waterfront District*.

Day 12: Hyannis, MA

Your guide will meet you this morning for a *Guided Hyannis Highlight Tour* to discover the hub of Cape Cod. Your tour includes the Kennedy Memorial, Hyannis Waterfront District, St. Xavier's Church, the neighborhood of the Kennedy Compound, and much more. Then you'll cruise from scenic Woods Hole Harbor for a *Martha's Vineyard Cruise and Tour* to see "Storybook Island" of Martha's Vineyard. See the famous Gingerbread Houses, Island Tabernacle, Antique Carousel of Oak Bluffs, and more while hearing the history and exciting stories of the area.

Day 13: Hyannis, MA – Danville, PA

As you journey home, you'll stop at the *Bruce Art Museum* in Greenwich, CT, for a guided tour. This museum is said to be "where art meets science" and is a world-class museum featuring art, science, and natural history exhibits.

Day 14: Danville, PA – Findlay, OH

Today, you'll stop in Canton, OH, to tour the ever-famous *Pro Football Hall of Fame*. Considered America's premier sports museum, it is an interactive experience, capturing the passion and energy of pro football from the history to the thrills of today's game.

Day 15: Findlay, OH - Wisconsin Dells, WI

Arriving in South Bend, IN, you'll make a stop at the *South Bend Chocolate Company* for a tour. Here, you can learn when, where, and how chocolate was created while exploring the manufacturing facility.
